Focusing on **Prevention, Screening and Risk Prediction**, the Meeting will be of interest not only to clinicians, nurses, midwives and biomedical scientists, but also to many other categories of professionals with an interest in women's health, including public health and epidemiology specialists, research and healthcare managers and coordinators, health economists, healthcare policy makers and government officials, industry and funding body representatives, medical and science journalists and editors.

The Meeting will be structured according to the following four themes: **Cancer; Fetal and Neonatal; Obstetrics; Reproductive Health and Cross-disciplinary.**

WHAT MAKES THIS INTERNATIONAL MEETING UNIQUE:

- **Prevention, Screening and Risk Prediction focus** – ever more important as the world's population expands and ages, and healthcare burden worsens
- **UCL IfWH and RCOG** – two institutions at the forefront of innovation in women's health, coming together for the first time as hosts
- **Multidisciplinary format** – bringing together experts in adjacent and interdependent fields
- **Panel discussions** – half a day of debates:
 - life-cycle approach, from prenatal development to post-menopause
 - both established and potential strategies discussed
 - cost-effectiveness, as well as impact on life expectancy and quality of life, questioned
- **Consensus statement** – based on outcomes of panel discussions and setting out a 5-year roadmap for bringing research to life
- **Elizabeth Garrett Anderson Award for Best Poster and Oral Presentation** – to outstanding presenters in two categories: 'Clinical and Academic' and 'Nursing, Midwifery and Allied Health Professionals'
